Modular construction has many benefits over traditional, on-site buildings methods.

The buildings are constructed in a controlled factory environment where quality control is closely monitored.

The build time is unaffected by the vagaries of the weather and other potential site constraints leading to greater predictability of overall product length. Build times can be up to 50% quicker than conventional on-site methods.

Less waste generated than on-site builds. The predicted reduction in waste is in the region of 90%.

Up to 90% reduction in on-site builds vehicle activity leading to reducing carbon footprint.
